# KINGSLEY WALKERS



#### **Christmas Lunch**

The members of the Kingsley Walking Group were again affected by weather towards the end of 2024. Following Storm Bert the 26th November walk was rerouted when it was clear that our planned walk, alongside the River Severn in Shrewsbury, would only be suitable for those of over 2 metres in height and owning snorkels.

The resulting route in Chester more or less retraced our January path. The minor deviations included someone dropping into a wine shop and picking up their Christmas champagne order. The bottles were distributed amongst the group's haversacks for transport over the rest of the walk. Such, I guess, are the travails of leading a group of Cheshire walkers and I can only hope that all the bottles made it safely to the end point and back to the grasp of the owners unsampled. It did save them a separate trip into Chester.

We made good use of the Park and Ride bus for Chester and then the i-bus for getting to the start of the pre-Christmas Lunch walk on the 10th December. Margaret Thatcher allegedly said that anyone over 30 using the bus could count themselves a failure. Google has 'reliably' told me that it was actually Loelia Ponsonby, after her 1947 divorce from the Duke of Westminster. Afterwards, untroubled by Gruffalo, we continued our walk and met up with a second group at the Goshawk. After shedding some (not all) of our walking gear we headed inside for a thoroughly enjoyable Christmas Lunch. All our heartfelt best wishes were sent to group stalwarts Dave and Sue, who could not attend but were there in our thoughts and prayers.

There was a huge thank you for all the leaders and walkers who had made 2024 such an enjoyable year. Have a great Christmas and a Happy New Year. We will look forward to more walks in 2025, we walk 4-5 miles (to a pub) on the second Tuesday of each month and 7-10 miles on the fourth Tuesday.

#### Kingsley Players stage hit Broadway musical 'Annie'. (Wed 5 – Sat 8 February 2025)



.... the background story and the origin of the Camino de Santiago de Compostela?



Last month Bryan Bulloch who is a regular attender at the Hurst Church wrote about his walk - or more accurately his shuffle along the Camino to Santiago de Compostela notching up 64km in 7 days. Bearing in mind his long-standing Parkinson's diagnosis this completely unexpected achievement astonished Bryan as much as anyone else. His two nominated charities (Parkinsons UK and the Chester Neurotherapy Centre) both accessible via

*https://<u>www.justgiving.com/page/sabrina-bulloch-1729424656059</u>* have now raised over £5,900 with gift aid and will remain open for donations until the end of the year.

Since Bryan's December article, people have been asking about the origin of the Camino de Santiago.

The city of Santiago de Compostela lies in Galicia, northwest Spain. "Santiago" in old Spanish means "of Saint James" one of the twelve Apostles and patron saint of Spain. "Compostela" according to some scholars derives from the Latin "compositum tella" meaning a formal burial ground, while other scholars consider it derives from the Latin "campus stellae" meaning the field of the star (of which more later). "Camino" simply means the "path" or the "way".



According to legend the remains of the Apostle James were brought to Galicia for burial, but over the centuries the location of the burial site became forgotten. Legend then has it that in the 9th century, a shepherd guided by a bright star found burial remains that were identified as those of Santiago the Apostle whose sanctification is related to the many miracles that occurred around him during his evangelising work in Spain and Portugal. With the discovery of the remains of his body, the king in Oviedo ordered the construction of a church to guard the holy tomb. So, a desire was established throughout Spain to follow in the footsteps of the monarch, to pay tribute to the Apostle, and this has continued worldwide. From all corners of Spain, and from various points in Europe, Christians set out to walk to Santiago de Compostela. Even if there is no religious motive for doing the walk, it has become a 'must' in serious walkers' aims.



The scallop shell is an iconic symbol of the Camino de Santiago appearing on the regular route markers and set into the pavements in Santiago. The radiating lines on the shells are said to represent the many routes that lead to Saint James' tomb in Santiago. The shell icon can also be found across the world in churches dedicated to Saint James. Many of the Camino walkers have a scallop shell hanging from their backpacks.

Various rituals and customs are associated with the Camino de Santiago. For example, places along the way catering for walkers each have a unique identification stamp that walkers can stamp on their cards. If pilgrims can show evidence of having walked at least 100km when they reach Santiago they can obtain the "Compostela" certificate. There is a daily Pilgrim's Mass in the Cathedral. On some occasions a large censer (the Botafumeiro) is set spectacularly swinging over the nave. It is customary for pilgrims to embrace the statue of Saint James in the Cathedral.


