We are nothing if not determined, so we had a Zoom meeting and now we're planning to meet face to face in June.

At our last meeting we talked about Pride and Prejudice in preparation for a visit to Grosvenor Park to see the play by Storyhouse. We were surprised to find how many people were reluctant to start it, but once started, were hooked. The reasons were varied. Some people had read Pride and Prejudice at school which had left them with poor associations. Others felt that they know the story because of the many films that they'd seen. We all loved the language and the characters which were brought to life with biting narrative. The idea that women had to be "married off" really got us talking about how life has changed.

In June we are reading Swansong by Kelleigh Greenberg-Jephcott. We plan to meet on June 17th (not the second Tuesday) in a garden. This book could not be more different to Pride and Prejudice, being a book about gossip, slander and humiliation of New Your Socialites in the 1970s. Or is it a lot like Pride and Prejudice?

Kingsley Walkers - June Walks

We were delighted that both our walks in May took place as planned. The long walk was on Conway mountain and despite the weather, a good time was had by all. Everyone was delighted to be able to travel further afield. The Short Walk started at the Lymm Dam and included woodlands, canals, fields and a walk around the dam. We had lunch at the Church Green.

We have one June walk scheduled which will be a short walk in the Chester area on June 22nd. Sadly, the June Long Walk is cancelled as our regular leaders are taking advantage of our new-found freedom to get away.

If you'd like to join us on any of the walks, please get in touch in advance so that we can make sure that we follow any rules that are in force at the time and keep you up to date with our plans. The signs are good for us being able to get back to normal very soon.

Each month we plan to have two walks. The Long Walk is held on the second Tuesday of the month. Generally, it's about 8 to 10 miles and is a full day out with picnic lunch. The Short Walk is held on the fourth Tuesday and is up to 5 miles long. We start and end at a pub with optional lunch. Walks are led by volunteers from the group.

For anyone new to the area, the wild garlic in Big Wood is amazing this year. To get there, walk down Ball Lane, (pass Hall O Th Hey Farm) to the river, turn right and walk to Pickering's Caravan park. You really can't miss it! Return the way you came, or walk up Crewood Common Road (about ¾ mile), turn right at Ball Lane and walk home. There are lots of footpaths in the area too.
