On the whole we enjoyed Ian McEwan's "The Children Act". The meeting was well attended by 10 people and 2 others sent in reviews. We scored the book at 4.3 out of 5. We were all quite surprised by the way that the book challenged some of our prejudices which led to a lively and good natured debate.

We were invited by Radio 4 to take part in a recording of their Book Club programme. It was with Richard Flanagan who won the Man Booker last year for his novel "The Narrow Road to the Deep North". We were offered 5 places which we quickly filled. The recording was made in London and was a great experience – as well as a chance for a day out. We all agreed that having the author in the room gives a whole new dimension to the discussion and lots of new insights. The book was challenging but we were glad to have read it.

For our October meeting we have chosen "How to be Both" by Ali Smith as an example of a new book by someone that no one has read. So far the feedback is "mixed". The meeting promises to be lively.

Meetings are open to all and everyone is encouraged to come along. You don't need to have read the book so feel free to drop in and see how our meetings work. Most months we welcome new members and visitors to the group.

KINGSLEY PARISH COUNCIL VACANCY

PART-TIME CLERK/RESPONSIBLE FINANCIAL OFFICER (RFO)

Due to the retirement of the current post holder, Kingsley Parish Council is seeking applications for a Clerk & Responsible Financial Officer (RFO).

The post is part-time, for 8 hours per week, working mainly from home. Working hours are flexible but the post holder must be able to attend our monthly meetings. We offer excellent nationally based terms and conditions of employment. Annual salary is paid in accordance with the National Association of Local Councils and Society of Local Council Clerks Scale LC1 (from £8.61 per hour depending on qualifications and experience). There is no requirement for the post holder to live within the parish.

Specific responsibilities will include:

- Ensuring the parish council conducts its business lawfully;
- Administering the council's financial affairs and keeping proper records;
- Attending all council meetings (the third Tuesday evening of each month, excluding August);
- Ensuring that meeting papers are promptly prepared; and
- Managing communications with the borough council and other organisations.

Applicants should be computer-literate, experienced in the use of spreadsheets and accounts and have proven organisational and administrative skills. Experience in local government is desirable but not essential. Full training will be given.

FRACKING

Seismic tests are being carried out in Helsby by Tesla Enterprises for Igas to see if the area is suitable for fracking. Apparently the survey area includes Frodsham marshes but not Frodsham town itself.

The results of the survey should be available for early November. Cllr Andrew Dawson of CW&C says that Igas will publish the results and he has said that if the company wants to frack for shale gas then there will be full public consultation.

There are many arguments for and against 'Fracking'. Two major energy debates have already been held jointly by Kingsley Transition Initiative and Frodsham Transition Initiative and these groups will be keen to ensure that any public consultation is well publicised and organised.

We urgently need more drivers, cooks and helpers.

Frodsham OPAL offers a fun day out once a week for older people living in the community who don't get out much; have trouble accessing public transport; have a carer who could do with a break or just don't get the opportunity to socialise much. We have various activities morning and afternoon, such as armchair exercise, quizzes, craft, speakers, music, games and bingo. Members also particularly enjoy their home cooked two course lunch, for some this is the only meal they eat each week with other people. Transport can be provided and members are charged just £10.

Volunteers can claim expenses and training is provided. No experience is necessary. We work on a rota and volunteers can sign up for the hours that suit them, be it weekly, fortnightly or monthly. Volunteering is extremely rewarding and members are so appreciative of all the hard work and enthusiasm that goes into the day-to-day running of the Club.




